

**IMPORTANT SHIPPING INFORMATION**  
**THIS ITEM VACUUM SEALED - OPEN IMMEDIATELY**

To reduce your shipping cost and for better protection during shipping, this item may have been compressed vacuum sealed and wrapped with two protective outer layers the same day it shipped.

As with all foam products, they will bounce back quickly to their original shape and will be unaffected by the compression process if opened within one week.

Because this item may have been in transit for many days it is **IMPORTANT THAT YOU OPEN IMMEDIATELY** so the item may decompress as soon as possible.

**DO NOT** remove outer packaging with a knife or box cutter as you may cut through the packing material and into the vinyl of the enclosed item. Instead **CAREFULLY** cut away the two packing layers using scissors.

In some cases we may have left a zipper slightly open to allow the air to be vacuumed out of the product. In these cases first allow the item to expand and then finish by closing the zipper.
